Little Sprouts, Junior Program
Summer Recreation Program & Before & After School Enrichment

What's FAOSP? The Faulkton Area Out of School Program is a licensed, non-profit childcare service that offers academic enrichment /recreation opportunities for children. We offer the following programs: "The FAOSP" a before/after school program for ages 5-13; "The Jr. Program" an all-day child-care with an openly structured preschool atmosphere for ages 4-5; "The Summer Rec Program" an all-day recreation/summer camp program for ages 5 – 13; and "Little Sprouts" a licensed group daycare for ages 6 weeks and older. Note, "sprouts" are moved up to the Junior Program when they are potty trained, at least 4 years old and ready for a preschool-like atmosphere. Junior Program children are moved up to the FAOSP when they are at least 5 years old, enrolled in Kindergarten, and capable of being in a school environment.

Tidbits about the School-Year and Junior Program

Open Times: Jr. Program 7:30am-6:00pm M-F
Before School Care 7:30am - 8:30am M-F (or later on late start days)
After School Care 3:30 – 6pm M-F (or earlier on early release days)
*No School Days 7:30am – 6pm M-F (*Must have a min of 6 pre-registered to be open)

Ages: Jr. Program: 3-5 years FAOSP: 5 – 13 years

Cost: The program operates on contracted days per week and uses the following fee schedules to calculate the weekly fee. Weeks are pro-rated for holidays. The program accepts walk-in participants if space permits.

Jr. Program Contracts: Full Day (>5 hours) = \$22/day Half Day (≤ 5 hours) = \$15/day
Minimum charge of \$45/week. You will set your contract at the beginning of the year and pay that rate regardless of usage. Extra attendance in the week will be charged at the Walk-in rates listed below. Contracts can be modified with a 2-week written notice.

Before/After School Contracts:	Additional Fees for No School	Walk-in
2 days/week = \$15.00/week	Plus \$15 on top of contract Full Day >5 hrs	\$30/Full Day
3 days/week = \$21.00/week	Plus \$10 on top of contract Half Day ≤5 hrs	\$20/Half Day
4 days/week = \$26.00/week	Plus \$5/Early release or Late Start Days	\$8 Before/After School
5 days/week = \$30.00/week		

The director will help you set your payment schedule, weekly, bi-weekly, or monthly. Weekly is recommended. You are welcome to pay in advance.

This program is licensed and therefore is eligible for daycare assistance with the state of SD. More information regarding assistance is available on <http://dss.sd.gov/childcare/childcareassistance/>

A scholarship program is also available for the special programs (i.e. dance, tumbling, tae kwon do, etc.). More information can be obtained from the program director.

Activities: The program will have activities each day to help enhance the education/experience for your child. We have a structured schedule with time for big motor skills (play), recreation, arts & crafts, music and educational enhancement – which also includes help with homework. **Throughout the year we also include special programs such as swimming, tumbling/gymnastics, tae kwon do, dance, canvas painting, cooking club, music activities, STEAM (Makerspace), sports and more.**

Location: Faulkton Community Center (connected to the school)

Instructors: Our instructors have specific education requirements to meet our daycare licensing. We are required to have one instructor per 15 children for school age and 1-10 for 4-year-olds. All staff complete a background check and are certified in CPR/AED and First Aid.

Lunch/Snacks: Breakfast, lunch and snacks are provided by the program. Meals are planned by a Registered Dietitian. These meals are included in the cost of the program. If your child has specific allergies, this will need to be discussed with the program director.
