What's FAOSP? The Faulkton Area Out of School Program is a licensed, non-profit childcare service that offers academic enrichment /recreation opportunities for children. We offer the following programs: "The FAOSP" a before/after school program for ages 5-13; "The Jr. Program" an all-day child-care with an openly structured preschool atmosphere for ages 4-5; "The Summer Rec Program" an all-day recreation/summer camp program for ages 5 – 13; and "Little Sprouts" a year-round licensed group daycare for ages 6 weeks and older. Note, "sprouts" are moved up to the Junior Program when they are potty trained and ready for a preschool-like atmosphere. Junior Program children are moved up to the FAOSP when they are at least 5 years old, enrolled in kindergarten, and capable of being in a school-age environment.

Tidbits about the Summer Recreation Program

Open Times: 7:30am – 6pm

Because we run on weekly contracts, the official Summer Program start date will be **May 20**. May 17th will be the end of the school year program. Note: **The summer program will be closed on May 27, July 4 & 5**

Ages: 4 – 13 years. Note: Children are grouped according to age. Children ages 4 -6 who have not finished Kindergarten will be considered Jr. Program children for the summer month. The Jr. Program has a separate space within our main building and these children will rarely be mixed in with the older children.

Cost: The program operates on contracted days per week and uses the following fee schedule to calculate the weekly fee. Weeks are pro-rated for holiday days. The more days you contract for in one week, the less expensive each day becomes. Full-time cost is \$22/day for the first child and \$20 for each additional child. The program accepts walk-in participants if space permits. *There is also a \$40 summer enrollment fee per contracted child to cover Community Transit and special activity/field trip costs. \$80 Family Max. This is expected to be paid at the time of registration.*

Sorry – no ½ day rates for contracted children.

The director will help you set your payment schedule, weekly, bi-weekly, or monthly. Bills are sent monthly via email or text at the end of each month. You can pay in advance.

This program is licensed and therefore is eligible for daycare assistance with the state of SD. More information regarding assistance is available <http://dss.sd.gov/childcare/childcareassistance/>

Activities: The summer program follows weekly themes and has special activities each day. We follow a structured schedule with time for big motor skills (play), recreation, arts & crafts, music, cooking, sports, and educational enrichment. We are a mobile group and spend time throughout the week at the park, pool, ball diamond, and library. Walking shoes are a must! We transport the children to and from swimming lessons.

Transportation: Summer transportation to and from locations in city limits is provided by Faulk County Transit. All children are required to wear seatbelts. Out-of-town field trip transportation is provided by Forman Bussing Co. The program director will take care of scheduling transportation for normal program activities - Swimming Pool, City Park, Swimming Lessons. **However, the program will not pay for nor provide transportation to activities not associated with the FAOSP (i.e. summer school, ball practice, Dr. appointments, etc.). This should be coordinated by the parent for their child.**

Location: 109 13th Ave North, Faulkton, SD 57438

Instructors: Our instructors have specific education requirements to meet our daycare licensing. All staff complete a background check and are certified in CPR/AED and First Aid.

Lunch/Snacks: Breakfast, lunch, and snacks are provided by the program. Meals are planned by a Registered Dietitian. These meals are included in the cost of the program. If your child has specific allergies, this will need to be discussed with the program director.
